

The Board of Supervisors met at the Township Office Building for their regular meeting on May 20, 2021, 7:30PM with Lowell Fry, Jere Swarr & Mark Erb present. The meeting was called to order by the Chairman and followed with the Pledge of Allegiance.

The minutes of the May 6th Meeting were distributed. **Mr. Erb made a motion to approve the Minutes as presented; second by Mr. Swarr. All voted in favor.**

POLICE REPORT

Chief Joe Stauffer reported on the statistics for April which included 32 traffic tickets, 1 non-traffic tickets, 9 criminal arrests, 32 warnings, 7,898 vehicle miles, 221 incident reports and 20 traffic accidents. Manheim Borough Police Department received a complaint about speeding in the 2700 block of North Colebrook Road. On 5/17/2021 Chief Stauffer sent 2 officers out for a speed detail in that area resulting in 49 vehicles times with an average speed of 40.765 in the 35-mph zone. Chief Stauffer also placed the Township speed sign there for 7 days of data that will be collected on 5/21/2021. Chief Stauffer also reported that the Police cruisers upfitting with the new logo has been complete. The cruisers will now have Rapho Township on the side logo along with the Township shamrock on the patch decal. Manheim Borough Police Department was audited by the Pennsylvania Juvenile Court Judge's Commission on 4/21/2021 on how juveniles are being handled with the department. No violations or problems were found.

Mr. Swarr made the motion to approve the isolation distance waiver for Mark Sites, 1152 Lebanon Road, sewage permit application; Second by Mr. Erb. All voted in favor.**

Consider Ordinance 2021-2 An Ordinance Repealing Township Ordinance No. 3 Known as the Rapho Township Junkyard and Refuse Ordinance. – **Mr. Wenger stated that the junkyard and refuse ordinance is from 1965 and has not been utilized since 2018 when the Township stopped collecting fees for junkyard registration. This resolution has been made obsolete by the township zoning ordinance and state environmental regulations. Mr. Swarr made the motion to adopt ordinance 2021-2 ordinance repealing the Township ordinance No. 3 known as the Rapho Township Junkyard and Refuse Ordinance; Second by Mr. Erb. All voted in favor.**

Consider Resolution 2021-7 "Resolution Terminating the Township's Declaration of Disaster Emergency related to COVID-19 and Certain Related Policies" – **Mr. Wenger explained to the board that this resolution will end the emergency declaration made in March 2020 and reaffirmed in March 2021 following Lancaster County ending their emergency declaration, Mr. Wenger consulted with Lori Shenk, the Township's Emergency Management Coordinator and it was determined that it was advisable to end Rapho Township's Emergency Declaration. This resolution will also end two interim COVID-19 Policies enacted in September 2020. The Township's telecommuting policy will remain in place as it has severe weather applications as well. Mr. Erb made the motion to approve resolution 2021-7 "Resolution Terminate the Township's Declaration of Disaster Emergency related to COVID-19 and Certain Related Policies"; Second by Mr. Swarr. All voted in favor.**
