OLD BUSINESS

American Rescue Funds – Mr. Erb asked Township Manager Randall Wenger what his goals would be for the funds should the township apply for them. Mr. Wenger said he would like to see the funds be used by writing 1 or 2 checks for a large community project(s) rather than many small projects. He said public sewer and water would be an acceptable project for the funds. Mr. Fry said he feels the township should apply for the funds and if the Board can't make a decision on how to spend it, they can send it back. **Mr. Erb made a motion to authorize the Township Manager and Assistant Secretary to apply on Rapho Township's behalf to the PA Department of Community and Economic Development (DCED) for Rapho Township's allocation of \$1,287,849.98 of the American Rescue Funds; second by Mr. Swarr. All voted in favor.**

NEW BUSINESS

Mr. Swarr made a motion to approve Ordinance 3-2021 amending the Rapho Township Pension Plan for Non-Uniformed Employees; second by Mr. Erb. All voted in favor. This ordinance corrects the typographical error from the change in March that resulted in not grandfathering existing employee that were intended to be.
